"Her previous horse developed neurologic problems and could not be shown. We could not have found a nicer replacement. He was shown at Region 2 and Region 3 and won 2 Championships, 3 Reserve Championships, and One Top 5 in very large and competitive classes. At Youth Nationals he was Top 10 in both JTR and JOTR Hunter Pleasure 14-17 with over 70 horses, and was Top 10 in the JOTR Western Pleasure 14-17. We call him Cyzzle and what is amazing about him is no matter what we ask him to do, hunter pleasure, western pleasure, or equitation, he does it well. We showed him at the regional level to determine whether to show him in Hunter or Western divisions at Youth Nationals. He was so good at both we decided to show in both and he was fabulous. Many people even came up to us and said they thought he should have won the Western Pleasure Championship; it was just a perfect ride. At the Region 3 pre-show he won every class in both hunter and western divisions and people were kidding my daughter about paying off judges, but he was so good they knew it wasn't the case."

"He is eight years old, sired by Cytosk+++ x Moonlightting. He was bred by Carrie or Shirley Gadbow. We worked with Cari Thompson who kept him in training for the short time we have owned him. He has a sweet personality, very kind, but we call him 'the talker' because when we walk in the barn he starts neighing until we get him out, and if we get our other horses out first he just keeps 'talkin' until we get to him. He is regretfully for sale since my daughter (Angeline Ruppert) is off to college. He will make some youth/amateur rider a wonderful horse.
